to school will I?

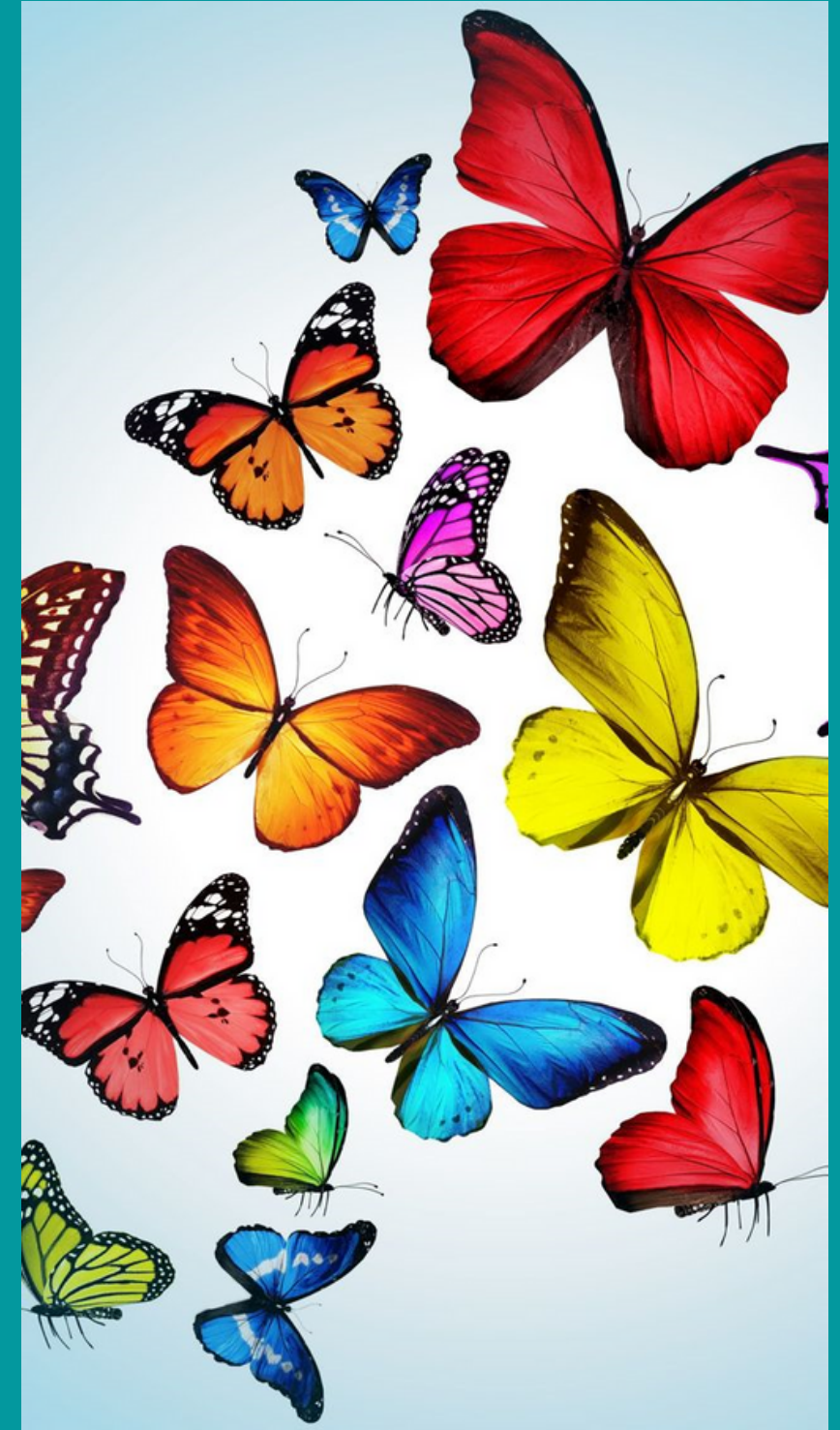


On special days I might wear my fancy clothes

We sit at the table for a drink and a snack

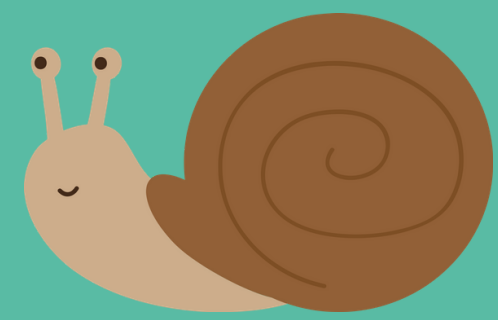


Then I put my plate and cup in the dishwasher
